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### Artist Rules and Regulations

**\*WILL BE CHECKED AND CONFIRMED BY LOCAL HEALTH TEAM\***

Hygienic - Requirements and Standards set for the Jackpot Tattoo and local tattoo artists are in the best interests of the public and comply with state tattooing and piercing guidelines.

**ANY PRACTITIONERS WHO CANNOT ADHERE TO THESE REGULATIONS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO WORK.**

Mandatory Materials - will be inspected at Friday morning inspections by local health team

1. State License or Health Certificate from local place of business.
2. Current blood borne certificate
3. Spore Test Verification document (See spore test section)
4. Disposable Single Use Gloves
5. Single Use Razors
6. Sharps containers (Bring your own and take with (NO EXCEPTIONS))
7. Hazmat container for used equipment (Tupperware) Do not leave these materials on site.
8. Nonabsorbent Waste Containers with trash can liners
9. Barrier wraps (Power supplies, tattoo machines, clip cords, and bottles)
10. Soap and alcohol bottles will be clearly marked.
11. Germicidal or super sani cloth wipes for disinfection surfaces.
12. Single use rinse cups
13. Sterile containers of ink
14. Single use ink cups
15. Healing instructions including shop name, phone number, address, and artist's name.
16. Waivers and documentations sheets must be given to each client.
17. Artists must wear clean clothing and be free of skin infections.
18. Tattooing will not be performed on anyone drunk, high, or pregnant.
19. Artist must provide carpet/ floor covering.

Spore Test - Non applicable if using single use disposable equipment. Others will need an accredited laboratory Spore Test from their sterilization equipment dated within a month of the show. All needles, tubes, and piercing equipment must be wrapped, contents identified and dated with no signs of tampering and sterilized OE gas packaging. Bring enough disposable equipment to work all weekend, there may be no supply company on hand. Smoking is not allowed in convention centers.

All drinks will be kept out of the booth areas.
